



BC Team Selection Criteria

As approved by a motion of the Player Development Committee in 2009 at the Player Development Committee meeting in Victoria, BC the following policy has been used for the selection of teams representing B.C. at national and international competitions. The goal of the selection is to pick the most promising players, developing or elite, to represent the province of British Columbia for golf.

All team selections are to be reviewed and vetted by a British Columbia Golf Team Selection Committee. The Selection Committee shall be comprised of a minimum of 3 members, Board and/or BC Golf Staff/Coaches.

The eight selection points listed below are not ranked in order, but are all encompassing for discussion purposes and to make a fair and final decision.

1. Current Season Performance : Provincial results with consideration of national performance ranking
2. Past Performance (2 years): Provincial team experience will be considered an asset plus any multi-sport games results.
3. Age Appropriate - As per the requirements of certain competitions and divisions for example: GJAC, North Pacific & Eddie Hogan Cup Matches, ages are 18 and under and not attending college. This is a requirement of the host organization as per the invitation to participate.
4. Stage of Development – based on the Long Term Player Development Guide for Golf in Canada, for the competitive pathway of Learn to Compete, Train to Compete, Train to Excel and Excel stages
5. Current Provincial and National Order of Merit (OOM) Ranking
6. Participation in Training* (this criteria was added in 2011): Participation in provincial and/or regional British Columbia Golf training camps or sessions. Consideration of exemption will be given to B.C. players on the national team program who have a current defined training program in place.
7. Regional Selection: A player selected based on geographical representation from various zones of the Association shall be considered
8. Provincial BC Coaches' Recommendations and Reports

A player must be in good standing with British Columbia Golf Association to be considered or selected for a BC Team.

A player exemption policy will be developed to allow the Association to select players to national and international teams and any exemption must be approved by the Executive Committee and/or the Board of Directors as per the recommendation of the CEO.

The Inter-Provincial BC Team members are selected based on the player's performance at the respective provincial championship during the current year of play; normally the team is comprised of the top 3 players in each division to represent British Columbia at the Canadian National Championships.

Based on the discretion of the Association, an alternate or an exempt player can be selected to represent the provincial team. Requires approval of the President.
